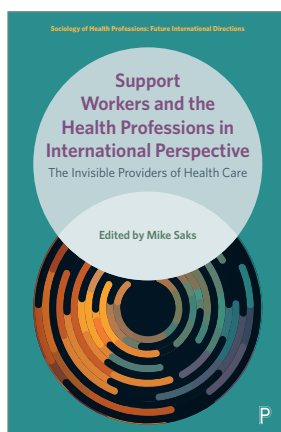
This series centres on the production of high quality, original work in the sociology of health professions with an innovative focus on the likely future direction of such professions.
