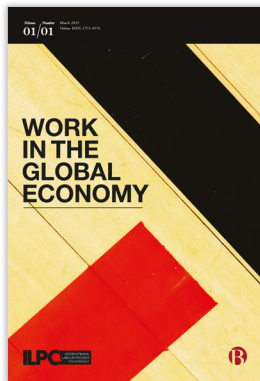


WORK IN THE GLOBAL ECONOMY
